Attention Health Care Providers:

In the near future, the Screening Program for Breast Cancer report will be available on the provincial eHR Viewer and a result letter will no longer be sent to you by mail. Individuals will be able to access their report on their MySaskHealthRecord platform. A result letter will continue to be sent to the individual.

ABNORMAL SCREENING MAMMOGRAM RESULTS

If you have signed a Medical Directive for Navigation services from the SPBC, a Nurse Navigator will continue to coordinate the follow up as recommended on the report issued by the Radiologist who read the SPBC mammogram.

If you have not signed a Medical Directive, and you are the individual's health care provider, you are responsible for all follow up recommendations.

Please note that in all cases:

- The diagnostic center will send **all results** to the health care provider.
- Women are instructed to follow up with their health care provider to discuss test results.
- Health care providers are responsible for arranging biopsies and any further follow up studies including surgical referrals.
