EXTRACT OF THE COUNCIL MINUTES FOR JULY 5, 2002

192g The Competency Hearing Committee unanimously concluded that Dr. Henry Wrobel does not have adequate skill and knowledge to practice medicine.

193g Dr. Wrobel did not appear before Council to speak to the findings of the Competency Hearing Committee.

MOTION

THAT the Council of the College of Physicians and Surgeons orders as follows:

- 1. Pursuant to Section 45(12)(e) of *The Medical Profession Act, 1981* the Council of the College of Physicians and Surgeons requires Dr. Henry Wrobel to meet with Val Hartley of Calder Centre in Saskatoon, Saskatchewan, *and* to take such form of upgrading, retraining or education as may be determined appropriate by Val Hartley in relation to the prescribing of psychoactive medications. The Council of the College of Physicians and Surgeons further directs that, in the event Dr. Henry Wrobel has not met with Val Hartley by August 1, 2002, or has not completed the form of upgrading, retraining or education in relation to the prescribing of psychoactive medications as may be determined appropriate by Val Hartley by October 1, 2002, the privileges of Dr. Henry Wrobel as a duly qualified medical practitioner shall be suspended until the required upgrading, retraining or education in the prescribing of psychoactive medications is completed.
- 2. Pursuant to Section 45(12)(e) of *The Medical Profession Act, 1981* the Council of the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Saskatchewan requires Dr. Henry Wrobel to meet with Dr. Penny Davis of Saskatoon, Saskatchewan, and to take such form of upgrading, retraining or education as may be determined appropriate by Dr. Penny Davis in relation to the practice of medicine. The Council of the College of Physicians and Surgeons further directs that, in the event Dr. Henry Wrobel has not met with Dr. Penny Davis by August 1, 2002, or has not completed the form of upgrading, retraining or education as may be determined appropriate by Dr. Penny Davis by December 31, 2002, the privileges of Dr. Henry Wrobel as a duly qualified medical practitioner shall be suspended until the required upgrading, retraining or education is completed.
- 3. Pursuant to Section 45(12)(e) of *The Medical Profession Act, 1981* the Council of the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Saskatchewan requires Dr. Henry Wrobel to complete the course in record keeping offered by the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Ontario, such course to be completed by December 31, 2002. The Council of the College of Physicians and Surgeons further directs that, in the event Dr. Henry Wrobel has not completed the course in record keeping offered by the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Ontario by December 31, 2002, the privileges of Dr. Henry Wrobel as a duly qualified medical practitioner shall be suspended until he has completed that course.

- 4. Pursuant to Section 45(12)(e) of *The Medical Profession Act, 1981* the Council of the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Saskatchewan requires Dr. Henry Wrobel to complete the course in therapeutics and prescribing offered by the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Ontario, such course to be completed by December 31, 2002. The Council of the College of Physicians and Surgeons further directs that in the event Dr. Henry Wrobel has not completed the course in therapeutics and prescribing offered by the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Ontario by December 31, 2002, the privileges of Dr. Henry Wrobel as a duly qualified medical practitioner shall be suspended until he has completed that course.
- 5. The Council of the College of Physicians and Surgeons reserves the right to provide an extension of time for Dr. Henry Wrobel to complete any upgrading, retraining or education referred to in paragraphs 1 to 4 above.
- 6. Pursuant to Section 45(12)(f) of *The Medical Profession Act, 1981* the Council of the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Saskatchewan requires Dr. Henry Wrobel to complete an assessment of his skills and knowledge following completion of the upgrading, retraining or education referred to in paragraphs 1 to 4 above. This assessment shall be done by a Competency Committee selected by the Council or the Executive Committee in the same manner provided for under Section 45(1) and (2) of *The Medical Profession Act, 1981* and the bylaws under that Act. The Council reserves the right to remove the requirement of a further assessment of Dr. Wrobel's skill and knowledge if, after reviewing reports relating to the upgrading, retraining or education required by paragraphs 1 to 4 above, the Council believes that Dr. Wrobel has demonstrated the necessary skills and knowledge to practice medicine with skill and safety in Saskatchewan.
